Edinburgh, 27 March: Neneh Cherry, Jarvis Cocker, Anna Calvi and Kate Tempest form part of a musical line-up showcasing some of today's most influential and original voices at **Edinburgh International Festival**, taking place from **2-26 August 2019**.

Alongside performances from the worlds of theatre, dance, opera and classical music in Scotland's capital, the International Festival will return to **Leith Theatre** – re-emerging as a vital venue for Edinburgh's contemporary music scene. In 2018's the International Festival's *Light on the Shore with Edinburgh Gin Seaside* brought to life Leith Theatre in a season which celebrated Scotland's most influential contemporary musicians and drew thousands of people to the newly re-opened venue. The entire 2019 contemporary music programme is supported by Edinburgh Gin.

Artists playing at Leith Theatre as part of the International Festival include: Pulp frontman and solo artist Jarvis Cocker bringing his new project **JARVIS** (22 August); Swedish rebel icon of trip hop **Neneh Cherry** with her latest album *Broken Politics*, produced by Four Tet (10 August); **Anna Calvi**, returning to the International Festival for the first time since 2015, following the release of her third studio album *Hunter* (11 August); poet, rapper, novelist and playwright **Kate Tempest** (9 August); and Danish indie rock group **Efterklang**, returning from a six-year hiatus performing unreleased songs as well as songs from their back catalogue, joined on stage by musicians from Denmark, Norway, Belgium and Lithuania (23 August).

Others include the New Jersey singer-songwriter **Sharon Van Etten** playing her new album *Remind Me Tomorrow* (21 August); folk-rock band **This is the Kit** led by Paris-based British musician Kate Stables (13 August); the legendary Scottish alt-rock band **Teenage Fanclub** playing songs from their three-decade catalogue, as well as premiering

new material (16 August); New Zealand-born multi-instrumentalist **Connan Mockasin** bringing his unique blend of psychedelic pop, backed by his full touring band (20 August); and Irish indie-folk band **Villagers** (15 August).

Three additional concerts at Edinburgh's Usher Hall and Royal Lyceum Theatre fuse roots music and folk traditions from across the world as part of **You Are Here – You Are Here** is an invitation to travel the globe with artists who offer us a fresh perspective on the world and ask big questions about the future of our communities, both local and international. American gospel travels back to its African roots as Malian duo **Amadou & Mariam** are paired with gospel music legends **Blind Boys of Alabama** (7 August); Edinburgh-based **Shooglenifty** brings its unique fusion of Scottish traditional music with Rajasthani band **Dhun Dhora** and Galician trio **Tanxugueiras** (9 August); and Lebanese folk pioneer and Arabic music innovator **Marcel Khalife** is joined by his son **Rami Khalife** and percussionist **Aymeric Westrich** to perform songs from Marcel Khalife's decades-long catalogue, as well as new compositions fusing classical, electronic and dance music by Rami Khalife (11 August).
